

# Adobe Illustrator Cheat Sheet



Viewing	
Fit on screen	Double-click on Hand tool or Ctrl-0
100% view level (actual pixels)	Double-Click on Zoom Tool or Ctrl-1
Zoom in	Ctrl-Plus(+) or Alt-Scroll wheel
Zoom out	Ctrl-Minus(–) or Alt-Scroll wheel
Hide all tools and panels	Tab
Hide all panels except Toolbox & Options bar	Shift-Tab
Scroll using Hand tool	Alt-Spacebar-Drag

Selecting and Moving	
To switch between Selection and Direct Selection tools	Ctrl-Alt-Tab
To cycle through tools behind column tool	Alt-click tool
To make copy while dragging	Alt
To add to a selection	Shift
Move Selection	Any arrow key
Move Selection 10 pts	Shift-any arrow key

Drawing Shapes	
Draw from center	Alt
Draw from center with dialog	Alt-click
Constrain proportion	Shift
Constrain orientation of polygons, stars, spirals	Shift
Move object while drawing	Spacebar
Add/subtract sides, points, spiral segments	Up or Down Arrow
Decrease inner radius	Ctrl
Create continuous duplicates along mouse movement	Hold tilde(~) while dragging

Other Shortcuts	
(In any panel) Apply a value, but keep value highlighted in panel	Shift-Return
Create new symbol	F8
Swap colors in a gradient	Alt-Drag a color stop onto another
Ctrl + S	Save

Y	Magic Wand
Q	Lasso
P	Pen
+	Add Anchor point
-	Delete Anchor point
Shift-C	Convert Anchor point
T	Type
\	Line Segment
M	Rectangle
L	Ellipse
B	Paintbrush
N	Pencil
Shift-E	Eraser
R	Rotate
O	Reflect
S	Scale
Shift-R	Warp
E	Free Transform
Shift-S	Symbol Sprayer
U	Mesh
W	Blend
Shift-O	Artboard Tool
H	Hand
Z	Zoom
X	Toggle between Fill & Stroke
Shift-X	Swap Fill & Stroke
D	Default Fill & Stroke (white fill/black stroke)
Double-click tools to bring up options.	
Press Caps Lock to change tool pointer to cross hair.	
Hold down Shift to constrain movement to 45°, 90°, 135°, or 180°.
